Announcements

Committee Reports

Prevention: No new announcements in the Prevention meeting. The Committee has decided to book Luzeda Hayes as the October 18th People in the Know speaker and will be looking for a treatment professional to also speak.

Treatment: Speakers were discussed for Faces of Change 2012. The Committee nailed down the majority of the FOC speakers and schedules and only need confirmation from one last speaker before finalizing the schedule and registration flyer. Registration fee will be \$65. Donna will contact a last speaker from the Suicide Prevention Coalition or Al-Anon.

Law Enforcement: Countermeasure fees for July totaled \$14,642.88. Vanderburgh County had 25 crashes involving alcohol, illegal and prescription drugs in July. 10 of those had injuries, 18 people we injured. 1 fatality involving alcohol/illegal or prescription drug crash. 8 DUI arrests and 11 minor consumptions arrests made by ISP. EPD and VCSO stats are not available.

Project Updates/Discussion

The Executive Board voted to accept the Race for Recovery contract presented to them by Jim Bush. Bush has been hired as the Race Director to head the event on April 20th, 2013.
