

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNCIL OF VANDERBURGH COUNTY, INC.

The undersigned incorporator desiring to form a mutual benefit corporation (the "Corporation") pursuant to the Indiana Nonprofit Corporations Law (IC 23-17-1-1), as amended, executes the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Corporation is:

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNCIL OF VANDERBURGH COUNTY, INC.

ARTICLE II

Statement of Purposes

2.01. The Corporation is a public benefit corporation.

2.02. Subject to the limitations herein expressed, the Corporation may engage in any lawful activity, and shall have the same powers as an individual to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its affairs.

2.03. The Corporation has been formed exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

2.04. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), or (b) by corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) 2 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

ARTICLE III

Registered Office and Registered Agent

3.01 Registered Office. The street address of the Corporation's initial registered office in Indiana is:

ARTICLE V

Membership

Membership and classes (if any). The Corporation's members shall be drawn from community organizations and agencies, both private and governmental, in accordance with the guidelines of the Governor's Commission For A Drug Free Indiana.

ARTICLE VI

Directors

6.01. Numbers of Directors. The initial Board of Directors is composed of (1) member. Nevertheless, the number of directors may be increased or decreased at any time, and from time to time, by the Corporation's bylaws. Under no circumstances, however, shall the number of directors be less than three (3).

ARTICLE VII

Other Provisions are Allowed to be Set Forth for Regulation and Conduct of the Corporation's Affairs

Other provisions for the regulation and conduct of the Corporation's affairs, and creating, defining, limiting or regulating the powers of the Corporation, the directors, or membership are as follows:

- (a) Except as otherwise may be provided by applicable law, no member, nor anyone on his or her behalf, is authorized to inspect or copy the membership list of the Corporation.
- (b) A member of the Corporation may participate in any annual, regular, or special meeting of the members by or through the use of any means of communication by which all members participating may simultaneously hear each other during the meeting. Each member so participating shall be considered to be present in person at the meeting.
- (c) On dissolution of the Corporation, it shall distribute its assets to an organization organized for a public or charitable purpose, a religious corporation, the United State of America, or any of its constituent states, or to a person that is recognized as exempt under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
